CDH Australia Rules For All Volunteers

1. No Volunteer can represent CDH Australia with out the prior approval of the board of directors. This includes representation at functions and events; form letters to members; donation and/or sponsorship requests, fundraisers; media representation; legal representation; or any other type of representation.
2. No Volunteer will conduct any type of service; fundraiser; request for donations, supplies, sponsorship, information, and/or assistance of any kind; or any event in the name of CDH Australia, without the prior approval of the board of directors.
3. No Volunteer will request any type of service, monetary donation of any kind, or item for personal use or benefit by using their role in CDH Australia as their reason for request.
4. No Volunteer will receive any type of personal or monetary compensation for their role in CDH Australia.
5. No Volunteer will give out medical advice to any member of CDH Australia or any person CDH Australia is providing services to.
6. All purchase of equipment or supplies must be pre-approved by the board of directors or must be in accordance with a budget that has been approved by the board of directors.
7. All mailing s(postal and e-mail)made to members or outside parties in the name of CDH Australia must be pre-approved by the board of directors or must be in accordance with a mail out strategy or plan that has been approved by the board of directors.
8. All member information is confidential and cannot be distributed in anyway to third parties, including other volunteers and members, for any reason. This includes names, address, phone numbers, e-mail addresses, and other personal information. The only information distributed will be included on our website, parent matches, and newsletter and distribution will be determined by the board of directors.
9. Volunteers are expected to perform the tasks and duties allocated to them by the board. Volunteers must not:
 - a. interfere in the tasks or duties of other volunteers;
 - b. perform tasks or duties, provide services, or engage in any conduct in relation to CDH Australia, that is not specifically allocated to them; or
 - c. delegate their tasks or duties to others, unless the board of directors has authorised the delegation.
10. Non-compliance with any of these rules will result in immediate withdrawal of your volunteer capacity, and may result in termination of your membership. Legal steps may be taken to recover compensation for any loss suffered by CDH Australia as a result of non-compliance with the rules.
